Consider this addendum an integral part of the above referenced solicitation:

Below are the questions and responses as per the proposal requirements.

- Q- Would it be of benefit for the City to have internet access, primary or secondary, at the City Municipal and/or Brush Creek locations? If so, we have the ability to provide MPLS, Internet, and SIP trunks on a single 100mb connection with failover between the two sites.
A- We already have dual ISP circuits at our Main Street location. We do not envision a need for a DIA circuit at our Brush Creek facility at this time
- Q- Can the SIP trunks be on the same circuit as the MPLS or do they need to be on separate circuits
A They need to be dedicated circuits
- Q- On the Drug-Free Workplace Affidavit, will a Board Authorized Representative be sufficient versus a principal officer.
A Whomsoever is authorized to bind your company to this requirement is sufficient.
