

SPECIAL CALLED MEETING

AUGUST 11, 2014

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF JOHNSON CITY, TENNESSEE held a Special Called Meeting in the Municipal Building, 601 East Main Street, Johnson City, Tennessee on Monday, August 11, 2014.

PRESENT: Commissioners Jeff Banyas, Jenny Brock and David Tomita, Pete Peterson, City Manager, and Leia Valley for Janet Jennings, City Recorder.

ABSENT: Mayor Ralph Van Brocklin and Vice-Mayor Clayton Stout.
The meeting convened at 5:59 p.m.

Upon motion by Commissioner David Tomita, seconded by Commissioner Jenny Brock, **Ordinance No. 4557-14**, "AN ORDINANCE TO CALL FOR A REFERENDUM TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF JOHNSON CITY BY DELETING A CERTAIN SECTION THEREFROM IN ITS ENTIRETY AND TO ENACT AND SUBSTITUTE IN LIEU OF THAT DELETED SECTION A NEW SECTION AND TO SUBMIT SAID AMENDMENT TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY OF JOHNSON CITY, TENNESSEE IN THE NEXT GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE FIRST TUESDAY IN NOVEMBER, 2014, AND TO REQUEST THE ELECTION COMMISSIONERS OF WASHINGTON, CARTER AND SULLIVAN COUNTIES, TENNESSEE TO PLACE THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT UPON THE OFFICIAL BALLOT," was **passed on second reading**. The motion **carried** by three ayes. There were no nay votes.

The meeting adjourned at 6:00 p.m.
